Parent Involvement Plan

1. Nettleton Junior High School (NJHS) will work with parents of Title I students to ensure that the district's goals relative to parental involvement in Title I programs and activities are developed and made available to all interested parties. The goals are as follows:
 - 1.1 To involve parents in the joint development of a parental involvement plan.
 - 1.2 To involve parents in the process of school review and improvement.
 - 1.3 To build the capacity for strong parental involvement in the school.
 - 1.4 To coordinate and integrate parental involvement strategies with other agencies.
 - 1.5 To conduct an annual evaluation of the effectiveness of the parental involvement policy.
 - 1.6 To use the results of annual evaluation to design strategies for school improvement , and if necessary, for revising policies.
 - 1.7 To provide materials and facilities to train parents, teachers, and pupil services personnel, principals, and staff to work with each other and work with parents as equal partner.
 - 1.8 To develop appropriate roles for community-based organizations and businesses and to encourage partnerships between elementary, middle, and secondary schools.
 - 1.9 To ensure, to the extent possible, that information sent home is in an understandable language and form for parents.
 - 1.10 To provide such other reasonable support for parental involvement activities as parents may request.

2. Nettleton Junior High shall implement the following statutory requirements:
 - * Put into operations programs, activities, and procedures for the involvement of parents with Title I, Part A, consistent with section 1118.
 - * Work to ensure that the required parental involvement policies meet the requirements of section 1118 of the ESEA and include a school-parent compact.

3. The plan developed will follow guidelines under section 1112 of ESEA:
 - * NJHS will provide full opportunities for the participation of parents with limited English proficiency, parents with disabilities, and parents of migratory children, to include providing information and school

reports required under section 1111 of the ESEA in an understandable and uniform format and, including alternative formats upon request, to the extent practicable, in a language parents understand.

* NJHS will follow the statutory definition of parental involvement, and expects to carry out programs, activities, and procedures in accordance with this definition: "Parental involvement means the participation of parents in regular, two-way, and meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities, including ensuring:

(A) that parents play an integral role in assisting their child's learning;

(B) that parents are encouraged to be actively involved in their child's education at school;

(C) that parents are full partners in their child's education and are included, as appropriate, in decision-making and on advisory committees to assist in the education of their child;

(D) the carrying out of other activities, such as those described in section 1118 of ESEA."

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE:

1. Nettleton Junior High School will take the following actions to involve parents in the joint development of its parental involvement plan:
 - * Annual Parent Title I Meetings to inform parents of their participation and involvement requirements and their rights to be involved;
 - * Need for the School-Parent Compact;
 - * Provide all parents with a copy of the Parental Involvement Policy each year;
 - * Meet with School Advisory Team to discuss survey results;
 - * Hold parent meetings to discuss and implement policy changes; and,
