Due to the Covid pandemic we will be doing everything possible to feed your child in a safe manner.

All households need to complete and return the lunch form to the Food Service Department. **If your child qualified for eligibility for the free or reduced lunch last year and a new form is not filled out and returned by September 17, 2020 their status will change to FULL PRICE WHICH IS \$2.50 FOR LUNCH AND \$1.00 FOR BREAKFAST.** Reduced price for lunch is \$.40 and \$.30 for breakfast. If you fill out a form and do not meet the requirements for free or reduced status then your child will change to full paid. On this date.
