

NOTIFICATION TO PARENTS REGARDING THE RELEASE OF STUDENT INFORMATION TO MILITARY AND IHL RECRUITERS

Dear Parent:

Federal law requires each Local Educational Agency (LEA), upon request of a military recruiter or an institution of higher learning, access to names, address, and telephone numbers of high school students. A parent may submit in writing to the LEA that such student information not be released without prior written consent of the parent.

If you wish to provide written consent prior to the release of this information you may use the below example and return it to your child's school. However, please be aware that if you choose not to return the form at this time, you may do so at any time during your child's school career. The request will be honored and it will be saved as a student record.
